

(5447.) MARLBOROUGH CARPENTERS, PAINTERS, PLUMBERS, AND  
BRICKLAYERS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Marlborough Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Marlborough Carpenters, Painters, Plumbers, and Bricklayers' award dated the 24th day of July, 1918, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xix, p. 657.

UPON reading the application of the Marlborough Building Trades' Industrial Union of Workers filed herein on the 11th day of April, 1919, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Clause 2 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following provisions substituted therefor:—

“ 2. (a.) The minimum rates of pay shall be: For carpenters, 1s. 7½d. per hour; for painters, 1s. 7½d. per hour; for plumbers,

if registered under the Plumbers Registration Act, 1912, 1s. 7½d. per hour; for plumbers, if not so registered, 1s. 6½d. per hour; for bricklayers, 1s. 7½d. per hour.

“(b.) In addition to the minimum rates above prescribed there shall be paid to the workers above mentioned a bonus of 2½d. per hour unless and until the Court shall otherwise order.”

2. Clause 13 of the said award shall be deleted.

3. This order shall operate and take effect from the 13th day of October, 1919.
