

## NORTHERN (AUCKLAND) INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.

### (5451.) AUCKLAND (FIFTEEN-MILES RADIUS) PERFORMING MUSICIANS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Auckland (Fifteen-miles Radius) Performing Musicians' award dated the 17th day of June, 1919, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xx, p. 535.

By virtue of the powers conferred by section 92, subsection (1) (a), of the said Act, and for the purpose of giving effect to the agreement of the parties and with the consent of the parties to the said award, this Court doth order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Subclause (e) of clause 2 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following provision substituted therefor:—

“(e.) Pianists employed in continuous-picture theatres shall be paid 2s. 8d. per hour, with a minimum of £3 per week.”

2. Clause 6 of the said award shall be deleted.

3. The name of the “Ponsonby Boys' Brass Band” shall be deleted from the list of parties to the said award.

4. The term of the said award, as set forth in the preamble to the said award and also in clause 16 thereof, shall be amended by striking out the year “1922,” and by substituting therefor the year “1921.”

5. This order shall operate and take effect from the 27th day of October, 1919.
