

(5130.) WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT IRON AND BRASS
MOULDERS.—ORDER GRANTING WAR BONUS.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Wellington District Iron and Brass Moulders' award (Book of Awards, Vol. xviii, p. 907).

UPON reading the application of the Wellington Iron and Brass Moulders' Industrial Union of Workers filed herein on the 8th day of February, 1919, and after hearing the representative of the said union and the representative of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers in that behalf contained in the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award be amended in manner following, that is to say,—

Clause 3 of the said award is amended by the addition thereto of the following clause:—

“ In addition to the said rates there shall be paid to the said workers a bonus of 2½d. per hour unless and until the Court shall otherwise order.”

This order shall come into operation and shall take effect from the 31st day of March, 1919.
