(5532.) CANTERBURY FEMALE BOOKBINDERS, PAPER-RULERS, AND CUTTERS.—ORDER ADJUSTING TERMS OF AWARD ON AMALGAMATION OF UNIONS.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Canterbury Female Bookbinders, Paper-rulers, and Cutters' award dated the 19th day of July, 1918, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xix, p. 645; and in the matter of the Christchurch Printing Trades' Industrial Union of Workers.

Monday, the 8th day of December, 1919.

UPON reading the application of the Christchurch Printing Trades' Industrial Union of Workers filed herein on the 19th day of November, 1919, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the said union, and the Court being satisfied that the Canterbury Printers' Machinists, Bookbinders, and Stereotypers' (including Transferers, Finishers, Paper-rulers, Cutters, Embossers, Machinists, and Paper-rulers' Assistants) Industrial Union of Workers desires to amalgamate with and to become merged in the Christchurch Printing Trades' Industrial Union of Workers, and that the requirements of section 20, subsection (1), of the said Act have been fully complied with, this Court doth order that the terms of the said award be adjusted in terms of section 20, subsection (2), of the said Act by substituting the name of the Christchurch Printing Trades' Industrial Union of Workers for the name of the union appearing in the said award.
