

(5162.) NORTH CANTERBURY GROCERS' ASSISTANTS.—ORDER
AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the North Canterbury Grocers' Assistants' award dated the 25th day of March, 1918, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xix, p. 163.

UPON reading the application of the Canterbury Grocers' Assistants' Industrial Union of Workers filed herein on the 21st day of March, 1919, and after hearing the representative of the said union and the representative of the employers, this Court, having regard to

all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and in pursuance and exercise of the powers contained in the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Clause 3 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following clause substituted therefor :—

“ 3. In addition to the minimum rates of pay provided for in this award there shall be paid to all workers coming within the scope of this award a bonus of 20 per cent. upon the said rates unless and until the Court shall otherwise order.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect from the 21st day of April, 1919.
