

(5772.) NORTHERN DISTRICT SADDLERS AND HARNESS AND BAG
MAKERS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Northern District Saddlers and Harness and Bag Makers' award dated the 12th day of February, 1919, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xx, p. 44; and in the matter of an order amending the said award dated the 16th day of October, 1919, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xx, p. 1153.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 16th day of February, 1920, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said order shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. By deleting clause 1 of the said order, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“(e.) In addition to the minimum wages prescribed by the award for the workers covered thereby there shall be paid, unless and until the Court shall otherwise order, the following bonuses, namely: To all journeymen, 3½d. per hour; to all females and apprentices, 2s. per week.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the 1st day of January, 1920.
