

(5783.) AUCKLAND (TEN-MILES RADIUS) WOOL AND GRAIN
STOREMEN.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Auckland (Ten-miles Radius) Wool and Grain Storemen's award dated the 22nd day of February, 1918, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xix, p. 25; and in the matter of an order amending the said award dated the 28th day of July, 1919, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xx, p. 749.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 9th day of February, 1920, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and by virtue and in exer-

cise of the powers conferred by the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award shall be further amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. By deleting clause 3 of the said award, and substituting the following clause:—

“ 3. During the currency of this award there shall be paid to all adult workers and youths coming within the scope of the award the following bonuses unless and until the Court shall otherwise order, viz.: To casual workers, 2½d. per hour; to permanent hands other than sewers, 9s. 6d. per week; to sewers, 9s. per week; to employees on shift-work, 9s. per week; to youths, 2s. per week. No bonus shall be paid on overtime rates.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the 1st day of January, 1920.
