(5834.) TARANAKI HOTEL EMPLOYEES.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Taranaki Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Taranaki Hotel Employees' award dated the 6th day of November, 1918, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xix, p. 1029.

Upon reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 21st day of February, 1920, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. In addition to the minimum wages prescribed in clauses 3 to 10 (inclusive) of the said award there shall be paid to male workers a bonus of 4s. per week and to female workers a bonus of 2s. per week as from the 1st day of January, 1920, which bonuses shall be increased to 10s. per week and to 5s. per week respectively as from the 1st day of May, 1920, and such bonuses shall be payable unless and until the Court shall otherwise order.

2. This order, subject as above provided, shall operate and take

effect as from the 1st day of January, 1920.
