

(5909.) DUNEDIN JOURNALISTS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Dunedin Journalists' award dated the 17th day of December, 1919, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xx, p. 1382.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 24th day of May, 1920, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. By the addition to clause 6 of the said award of the following subclause:—

“(e.) The minimum salaries prescribed in this clause shall be increased by the following bonuses unless and until the Court shall otherwise order, viz.: To cadets and copyholders a bonus of 2s. per week as from the 1st day of January, 1920, which bonus shall

be increased to 5s. per week as from the 1st day of May, 1920; to all other workers hereinbefore mentioned a bonus of 4s. per week as from the 1st day of January, 1920, which bonus shall be increased to 10s. per week as from the 1st day of May, 1920.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the respective dates mentioned in the above subclause.
