

(5912.) DUNEDIN (TWELVE-MILES RADIUS) BOOT-REPAIRERS.—
ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Dunedin (Twelve-miles Radius) Boot-repairers' award dated the 28th day of November, 1918, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xix, p. 1076; and in the matter of an order amending the said award dated the 12th day of March, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 204.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 26th day of May, 1920, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. The said order of the 12th day of March, 1920, is hereby cancelled, and this order substituted therefor.

2. The following subclause shall be added to clause 2 of the said award:—

“(e.) The rates above prescribed shall, unless and until the Court shall otherwise order, be increased by a bonus of 3½d. to hourly workers and by a bonus of 14s. per week to weekly workers.”

3. This order shall operate and take effect as from the 1st day of May, 1920.
