

(5980.) CANTERBURY INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT RETAIL SHOP-  
ASSISTANTS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Canterbury Industrial District Retail Shop-assistants' award dated the 17th day of September, 1919, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xx, p. 1086.

Tuesday, the 15th day of June, 1920.

UPON reading the application filed herein on the 31st day of May, 1920, by the union party to this award, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the said union and the duly appointed representative of the Canterbury Retail Drapers, Mercers, and Clothiers' Association, this Court, by virtue of the powers conferred by the said Act and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, and by consent, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

By adding to clause 10 of the said award the following additional subclause:—

“(d.) In establishments covered by this award within a radius of ten miles from the Chief Post-office in the City of Christchurch Easter Saturday shall be observed as a holiday in lieu of Anni-

versary day, provided, however, that if any retail draper, mercer, or clothier carrying on business within the City of Christchurch, and being a member of the said association, shall have failed to give such assistant a full holiday on Easter Saturday, 1920, then he shall give such assistant a full holiday on Anniversary Day, 1920, or in lieu thereof shall pay him for such holiday at the rates prescribed in this clause."
