(6003.) SOUTH CANTERBURY BUILDERS', CONTRACTORS', AND GENERAL LABOURERS.—ORDER ADDING PARTIES TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the South Canterbury Builders, Contractors, and General Labourers' award dated the 30th day of August, 1919, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xx, p. 939.

Upon reading the application of the union party to the said award, filed herein on the 14th day of June, 1920, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union, and having regard to the objections lodged by the parties hereinafter named, this Court doth order that the following County Councils shall be added as parties to the said award to the extent and in the manner following, that is to say:

1. They shall pay the wages prescribed in the said award or in any orders amending the same for any work coming within the

scope of the said award.

2. They shall pay overtime at the rates prescribed in the said award for any work done beyond the hours of work now customary respectively in the said County Councils.

3. The following are the County Councils above referred to: The Geraldine County Council, Geraldine; the McKenzie County

Council, Fairlie; the Waimate County Council, Waimate.

4. This order shall operate and take effect from the 5th day of July, 1920.
