

OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.

**(6031.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND METAL-WORKERS' ASSISTANTS.—
ORDER AMENDING AWARD.**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Metal-workers' Assistants' award dated the 2nd day of July, 1920.

By virtue of section 92, subsection (1) (a), of the said Act, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, this Court doth order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. By adding to clause 2 of the said award the following sub-clause:—

“(a.) In addition to the minimum rates above prescribed there shall be paid to the workers above mentioned a bonus of 3d. per hour unless and until the Court shall otherwise order.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the 12th day of July, 1920.
