

(6036.) AUCKLAND CERTIFICATED ENGINE-DRIVERS. — SUPPLEMENTARY AGREEMENT WITH THE DEVONPORT STEAM FERRY COMPANY (LIMITED) AND THE TAKAPUNA TRAMWAYS AND FERRY COMPANY (LIMITED).

THIS supplementary agreement, made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments, this 1st day of June, 1920, between the Auckland Certificated Engine-drivers Industrial Union of Workers (hereinafter called "the union") of the one part, and the Devonport Steam Ferry Company (Limited) and the Takapuna Tramways and Ferry Company (Limited) (hereinafter called "the employers") of the other part, whereby it is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:—

1. That the terms, conditions, stipulations, and provisions contained and set out in the schedule hereto annexed shall be binding upon the said parties, and they shall be deemed to be and are hereby incorporated in and declared to form part of this agreement.

2. The said parties hereto shall respectively do, observe, and perform every matter and thing by this supplementary agreement, and by the said terms, conditions, stipulations, and provisions, respectively required to be done, observed, and performed, and shall

not do anything in contravention of this supplementary agreement or of the said terms, conditions, stipulations, and provisions, but shall in all respects abide by and perform the same.

SCHEDULE.

*Bonus.*

1. That a bonus of 10s. per week be granted to each member of the union in the employ of the Devonport Steam Ferry Company (Limited) and the Takapuna Tramways and Ferry Company (Limited) during the term of such member's employment by the employers.

*Time to Commence.*

2. Such bonus to be paid as from the 1st May, 1920.

*Overtime.*

3. Overtime to be paid as per existing agreement, and no bonus to be taken into account in computing the amount of overtime payable.

*Terms of Agreement.*

4. Should the cost of living at any time hereafter decline, the employers reserve the right at any time, by giving one month's written notice to that effect, to be posted by registered letter to the last known place of business in Auckland of the secretary of the union concerned, to discontinue the payment of such bonus or any part thereof.
