

(6070.) WANGANUI (TEN-MILES RADIUS) WOOL AND GRAIN STORES  
EMPLOYEES.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wanganui (Ten-miles Radius) Wool and Grain Stores Employees' award, dated the 2nd day of June, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 681.

UPON reading the application of the employers, parties to the said award, filed herein on the 30th day of June, 1920, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said employers and of the union parties to the said award, this Court, by virtue of the powers conferred by subsection (1) (a) of section 92 of the said Act, and in order to remedy a defect in the said award, doth hereby order that clause 3 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following provisions substituted therefor:—

“ 3. All time worked between 6 a.m. and 8 a.m., and between 6 p.m. and 10 p.m. shall be paid for at the rate of 2s. 7d. per hour; and all time worked between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. shall be paid for at the rate of 3s. 10d. per hour.”

This order shall operate and take effect as from the 14th day of June, 1920.
