

(6117.) NEW ZEALAND MARINE COOKS AND STEWARDS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the New Zealand Marine Cooks and Stewards' award dated the 12th day of April, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 416.

UPON reading the application of the Union Steamship Company of New Zealand (Limited) party to the said award filed herein on the 21st day of June, 1920, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the said company and the duly appointed representative of the union party to the said award, this Court, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 92, subsection (1) (a), of the said Act, and in order to remedy a defect in the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say: By adding to clause 1 of the said award the following subclause:—

“(a.) Uniforms: Members of the stewards' staff shall provide themselves with, and wear on duty, the uniform (if any) of the service in which they are employed.”

This order shall operate and take effect as from the date hereof.
