

(6123.) CANTERBURY ELECTRICAL WORKERS.—ORDER AMENDING
AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Canterbury Electrical Workers' award dated the 2nd day of July, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 1002.

By virtue of the powers conferred by section 92, subsection (1) (a), of the said Act, and by consent of the parties, this Court doth order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. The following additional subclause shall be added to clause 7 of the awards:—

“(n.) The rates of wages herein prescribed for apprentices shall apply to all apprentices at present employed in any shop or factory.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the 16th day of April, 1920.
