

(6236.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT BOILERMAKERS, IRON-SHIP WORKERS, AND BRIDGE-BUILDERS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Boilermakers, Iron-ship Workers, and Bridge-builders' award dated the 2nd day of June, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 577.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the said award, filed herein on the 30th day of June, 1920, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, by virtue of the power reserved in the said award and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Clause 18 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following provisions substituted therefor:—

“ 18. The foregoing provisions of this award shall, so far as the undermentioned employers are concerned, be modified in manner following, that is to say—

“ (a.) Forty-four hours shall constitute a week's work, but may be worked within such hours as the exigencies of the employment may reasonably require, but shall not exceed eight in any one day.

“(b.) Overtime shall be paid for any time worked in excess of eight hours on five days of the week, or of four hours on the statutory half-holiday, at the rate of time and a half for the first three hours and thereafter double time.

“(c.) The said employers are exempted from the provisions of clause 13 of this award.

“(d.) Notwithstanding the provisions of subclause (e) of clause 5 of this award, the said employers may pay their workers in accordance with the custom prevailing in their respective establishments.

“(e.) The following are the employers above referred to:—

“The Auckland Harbour Board, Auckland.

The Devonport Steam Ferry Company (Limited), Auckland.

The Takapuna Tram and Ferry Company (Limited), Auckland.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the 18th day of October, 1920.
