(6244.) WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT ENGINEERS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District Engineers' award dated the 18th day of August, 1920.

By virtue of section 92, subsection (1) (a), of the said Act, and for the purpose of giving fuller effect to the said award, and by consent, this Court doth order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say,—

The following additional subclause shall be added to clause 15 of the said award:—

“(L.) All apprentices at present employed in any shop or factory of any employer bound by this award shall be paid the minimum rates prescribed for apprentices in subclause (a) of this clause.”

This order shall operate and take effect as from the 16th day of April, 1920.
