(6261.) CANTERBURY INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT RETAIL SHOP-ASSISTANTS.—ORDER ADDING PARTY TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Canterbury Industrial District Retail Shop-assistants' award dated the 17th day of September, 1919, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xx, p. 1086, and any amendments thereof.

Upon reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 8th day of June, 1920, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and the duly appointed representative of the Christchurch Gas, Coal, and Coke Company (Limited) and the evidence adduced by the said union, this Court doth order that the said company shall be added as a party to the said award as from the date hereof: Provided, however, that the said company shall be bound by the said award only in respect of the provisions thereof relating to wages. The said company is exempted from all the other provisions of the said award.
