

## CANTERBURY INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.

**(6302.) CANTERBURY MANURE, TALLOW, AND SOAP WORKERS.—  
ORDER AMENDING AWARD *RE* NIGHT SHIFTS.**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Canterbury Manure, Tallow, and Soap Workers' award dated the 2nd day of July, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 998.

UPON reading the application of the New Zealand Farmers' Co-operative Association of Canterbury (Limited), filed herein on the 26th day of October, 1920, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said association and of the union party to the said award, and by virtue of the powers reserved by clause 11 of the said award, this Court doth order that the following clause shall be added to the said award:—

“ 11A. The New Zealand Farmers' Co-operative Association of Canterbury (Limited) shall be entitled to work a night shift of eight hours, provided that such shift shall be of not less than eight hours and shall be paid for at 2s. 6d. in addition to the rates prescribed in the said award, and provided further that such shift shall be worked not less than five consecutive nights before it shall be deemed to be a night shift within the meaning of this clause.”

This order shall operate and take effect from the 8th day of November, 1920.
