

(5635.) CHRISTCHURCH ROTARY MACHINE PRINTERS.—ORDER
AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Christchurch Rotary Machine Printers' award dated the 6th day of September, 1919, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xx, p. 969.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 7th day of February, 1920, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. The following subclause shall be added to clause 2 of the said award:—

“(c.) In addition to the minimum rates above prescribed there shall be paid to the workers above mentioned the following bonuses unless and until the Court shall otherwise order, viz.: To weekly-wages men a bonus of 4s. per week, and to hourly-wages men a bonus of 1d. per hour.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the 1st day of January, 1920.
