

(6386.) TARANAKI SHEARERS AND SHED HANDS.—ORDER
AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Taranaki Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Taranaki Shearers and Shed Hands' award dated the 4th day of November, 1920.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 15th day of November, 1920, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Subclause (h) of clause 17 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following provisions substituted therefor:—

“(h.) The minimum rates prescribed in the foregoing sub-clauses of this clause shall, unless and until the Court shall otherwise order, be increased by the following bonuses respectively: To adult workers on weekly wages, 13s. per week; to adult workers on hourly wages, 3¼d. per hour; to youths on weekly wages, 6s. per week; and to youths on hourly wages, 1¾d. per hour.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the 1st day of November, 1920.
