

(6418.) NEW ZEALAND MARINE COOKS AND STEWARDS (COASTAL SHIPPING COMPANIES).—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the New Zealand Marine Cooks and Stewards' (Coastal Shipping Companies) award dated the 2nd day of September, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 1459.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 5th day of November, 1920, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. The minimum wages prescribed in the said award for all workers therein mentioned (except assistant cooks and stewards) shall be increased by a bonus of 10s. per month; and the minimum wages prescribed for assistant cooks and stewards shall be increased by a bonus of 3s. 6d. per month; and such bonuses shall be paid unless and until the Court shall otherwise order.

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the 1st day of November, 1920.
