

(6552.) TE KUITI LIME-WORKS EMPLOYEES.—ORDER AMENDING
AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Te Kuiti Lime-works Employees' award dated the 27th day of March, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 319; and in the matter of an order amending the said award dated the 21st day of February, 1921.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives

of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say:—

1. The said order dated the 21st day of February, 1921, is hereby cancelled, and this order is substituted therefor.

2. The following subclause is hereby added to clause 2 of the said award:—

“(b.) In addition to the minimum rates of wages prescribed in this clause there shall be paid a bonus of 2½d. per hour unless and until the Court shall otherwise order.”

3. This order shall be deemed to operate and take effect as from the 1st day of November, 1920.
