

(6556.) GREYMOOUTH (TWENTY-MILES RADIUS) RETAIL SHOP-ASSISTANTS (BUTCHERS' SECTION).—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Westland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Greymouth Retail Shop-assistants' (Butchers' Section) award dated the 10th day of February, 1921.

Thursday, the 24th day of February, 1921.

WHEREAS by section 92 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, it is enacted that the Court may at any time during the currency of an award (*inter alia*) amend the provisions of the award for the purpose of remedying a defect therein or giving fuller effect thereto; and it appearing to the Court that it is just and equitable to amend the said award for the purposes aforesaid, this Court, in pursuance of the powers in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby amend the said award in manner following, that is to say—

1. Clause 14 of the said award is hereby deleted, and the following provision substituted therefor:—

“*Scope of Award.*

“14. This award shall operate throughout that part of the Westland Industrial District within a radius of twenty miles from the Chief Post-office at Greymouth.”

2. This order shall be deemed to have operated and taken effect on and from the 1st day of January, 1921.
