(6618.) GREEN ISLAND IRON-ROLLING MILL EMPLOYEES.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Green Island Iron-rolling Mill Employees' award dated the 18th day of May, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 539.

Upon reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 15th day of February, 1921, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. The following clause shall be added to the said award:-

"13. In addition to the minimum rates of wages and cost-ofliving bonuses prescribed in this award there shall be paid, unless and until the Court shall otherwise order, the following extra bonuses, viz.: To workers receiving weekly bonuses (except boys), 3s. per week; to workers receiving hourly bonuses, \(\frac{3}{4}\)d. per hour; and to boys, 1s. per week. Trade bonuses are not affected by this provision. Pieceworkers who employ boys shall receive the amount of the extra bonuses paid by them in pursuance of this clause to the boys, in addition to the amount of the bonuses payable under this award to such pieceworkers themselves. All weekly bonuses payable under this award are declared to be 'at the rate of' the specified weekly sum."

2. This order shall be deemed to operate and take effect as from the 1st day of November, 1920.
