## (6630.) SOUTHLAND RETAIL GROCERS' ASSISTANTS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Southland Retail Grocers' Assistants' award dated the 1st day of November, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 2006.

Upon reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 17th day of January, 1921, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. The following subclause is hereby added to clause 2 of the

said award:-

"(e.) In addition to the minimum rates of wages prescribed in this clause there shall be paid, unless and until the Court shall otherwise order, the following bonuses, viz.: To workers in their first, second, third, fourth, and fifth year of service, a bonus of 1s. per week; and to all other workers affected by this clause, a bonus of 3s. per week."

2. Subclause (b) of clause 11 of the said award is hereby deleted,

and the following provision is substituted therefor: -

"(b.) In addition to the minimum rates of wages prescribed in this clause there shall be paid, unless and until the Court shall otherwise order, the following bonuses, viz.: To female workers over twenty-one years of age, a bonus of 6s. 6d. per week; and to females under the age of twenty-one years, a bonus of 6s. per week."

3. This order shall be deemed to operate and take effect as from

the 1st day of November, 1920.
