

(6631.) SOUTHLAND RETAIL GROCERS' ASSISTANTS.—ORDER
AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Southland Retail Grocers' Assistants' award dated the 1st day of November, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 2006.

UPON hearing application in that behalf, and being satisfied that it is just and equitable that the said award should be amended in the manner hereinafter appearing, this Court, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended as follows, that is to say—

1. By adding to clause 10 of the said award the following words: "Where an employer, not being a party to the Drivers' award for the time being in force, employs a worker wholly in driving, such worker shall be deemed to be an assistant within the meaning of this award."

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the date hereof.
