

(6667.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND ENGINEERS.—ORDER ADDING  
PARTIES TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 2nd day of July, 1920, and known as the Otago and Southland Engineers' award (Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 1027).

Saturday, the 12th day of March, 1921.

UPON reading the application of the above-named union of workers filed herein on the 22nd day of February, 1921, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the said union of workers and such of the persons, firms, and companies hereinafter named as appeared in person or by their representative duly appointed, this Court doth order that the following be and they are hereby added as parties to the said award as from the date hereof :—

Briscoe and Co. (Limited), Sheet-metal Workers and Brass-finishers, Princes Street, Dunedin.

Wilson Bros., Engineers, Leet Street, Invercargill.

Provided that Briscoe and Co. (Limited) shall be bound by the provisions of this award only in so far as the employment of brass-finishers is concerned; but nothing in the award shall apply to boys engaged in polishing brass fittings and hinges for steel window-sashes.
