

(6673.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT ENGINE-DRIVERS, FIREMEN, AND GREASERS. — ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Otago Engine-drivers, Firemen, and Greasers' award dated the 18th day of March, 1921.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by section 92 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, this Court doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Subclause (c) of clause 11 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following provision substituted therefor:—

“(c.) In addition to the rates prescribed in subclauses (a) and (b) of this clause there shall be paid to the workers therein mentioned a bonus of 6d. per day unless and until the Court shall otherwise order.”

2. This order shall be deemed to operate and take effect as from the 28th day of March, 1921.
