

(6704.) CANTERBURY IRON AND BRASS MOULDERS.—ORDER
AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Canterbury Iron and Brass Moulders' award dated the 21st day of June, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 831.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 10th day of November, 1920, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and by virtue and in exer-

cise of the powers conferred by the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Subclause (b) of clause 2 of the said award is hereby deleted, and the following provision substituted therefor:—

“(b.) In addition to the rates above prescribed there shall be paid to such workers a bonus of $3\frac{3}{4}$ d. per hour unless and until the Court shall otherwise order.”

2. The following additional subclause shall be added to clause 5 of the said award:—

“(k.) In addition to the minimum rates of wages above prescribed there shall be paid to apprentices, unless and until the Court shall otherwise order, a bonus of 1s. per week.”

3. The following subclause shall be added to clause 6 of the said award:—

“(a.) In addition to the minimum rate above prescribed for improvers there shall be paid, unless and until the Court shall otherwise order, a bonus of $\frac{3}{4}$ d. per hour.”

4. This order shall be deemed to operate and take effect as from the 1st day of November, 1920.
