

(6464.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT NURSERYMEN GARDENERS AND LANDSCAPE GARDENERS.—ORDER ADDING PARTIES TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 18th day of October, 1920, made in an industrial dispute between the Auckland Builders' General, and other Labourers' (Nurserymen Gardeners, Landscape Gardeners, and Seedsmen's Section) Industrial Union of Workers and W. Provided that nothing in the said award shall apply to the employment by the said Victor Smith at a wage of not less than £2 5s. per week of the female worker at present employed by him, so long as she is employed in the same work as heretofore.
