(6790.) GREYMOUTH (TWENTY-MILES RADIUS) RETAIL SHOP-ASSISTANTS (GENERAL SECTION).—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Westland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Greymouth (Twenty-mile Radius) Retail Shop-assistants' (General Section) award dated the 10th day of February 1921.

On application of the union, and with the consent of the employers, and for the purpose of remedying a defect, this Court, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by section 92 of the said Act, doth order that the award is amended in manner following, that is to sav—

1. Clause 20 of the said award is hereby deleted, and the following provision is substituted therefor:—

"Closing of Shops.

"20. All shops carrying on any of the businesses covered by this award shall close at 5.30 p.m. on four days of the week, at 9 p.m. on the day of the late night, and at 12 noon on the day of the weekly half-holiday."

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the date hereof.
