

(6793.) GREYMOUTH (TWENTY-MILES RADIUS) RETAIL SHOP-ASSISTANTS (GROCERS' SECTION).—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Westland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Greymouth (Twenty-miles Radius) (Retail Shop-assistants' (Grocers' Section) award dated the 10th day of February, 1921.

ON application of the union, and with the consent of the employers, and for the purpose of remedying a defect, this Court, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by section 92 of the said Act,

doth order that the said award be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. The following clause is inserted in the said award :—

“ Closing of Shops.

“ All shops carrying on any of the businesses covered by this award shall close at 5.30 p.m. on four days of the week, at 9 p.m. on the day of the late night, and at 12 noon on the day of the weekly half-holiday.”

2. Clause 4 of the said award is hereby deleted, and the following provision substituted therefor :—

“ 4. Forty-eight hours shall constitute an ordinary week’s work. The hour of ceasing work shall be 5.30 p.m. on four days of the week, at 9 p.m. on the day of the late night, and at 12 noon on the day of the weekly half-holiday.”

3. This order shall operate and take effect as from the date hereof.
