

(6811.) NORTH CANTERBURY LICENSED-HOTEL WORKERS.—
ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the North Canterbury Licensed-hotel Workers' award dated the 19th day of April, 1921.

In pursuance of the powers conferred on it by section 92 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments, and for the purpose of supplying an omission and remedying a defect in the said award, this Court doth order that the said award be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. The following additional subclause is hereby added to clause 5 of the said award (“ dining-room ”):—

“(e.) (i.) Housemaid, £1 10s.”

2. This order shall be deemed to operate and take effect as from the 9th day of May, 1921.
