(6812.) GREYMOUTH (TWENTY-MILES RADIUS) RETAIL SHOP-ASSISTANTS (GENERAL SECTION).—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Westland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908; and in the matter of the Greymouth (Twenty-miles Radius) Retail Shop-assistants' (General Section) award dated the 10th day of February, 1921.

Friday, the 6th day of May, 1921.

On application of the union, and with the consent of the employers, and for the purpose of remedying a defect, this Court, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by section 92 of the said Act, doth order that the said award be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Clause 3 of the said award is hereby deleted, and the following

provision is substituted therefor:—

"Hours of Work.

"3. Forty-eight hours shall constitute an ordinary week's work. The hour of ceasing work shall be 5.30 p.m. on four days of the week, 9 p.m. on the day of the late night, and 12 noon on the day of the weekly half-holiday."

2. This order shall be deemed to operate and take effect as from

the 28th day of April, 1921.
