(6837.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT ENGINE DRIVERS FIREMEN, AND GREASERS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Industrial District Engine-drivers, Firemen, and Greasers' award dated the 18th day of March, 1921.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by section 92 of the said Act, and for the purpose of remedying a defect and supplying an omission in the said award, this Court doth order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Subclause (b) of clause 11 of the said award shall be amended by adding thereto the following words: "Each man to have six days' holiday every year on full pay, or six days' pay extra."

2. This order shall be deemed to operate and take effect as from the 28th day of March, 1921.
