

(6840.) GISBORNE JUDICIAL DISTRICT BUTCHERS.—ORDER  
AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Gisborne Judicial District Butchers' award dated the 23rd day of February, 1921, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxii, p. 195.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by section 92 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, and with the consent of the parties, this Court, being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. The following clause is hereby added to the said award:—

“ 11A. The daily hours of work and the hours for closing butchers' shops prescribed in this award shall not apply to any shop in which the sole business carried on is that of a pork-butcher.”

2. The words and figures “ 4 p.m. ” in clause 11 of the said award are hereby deleted, and the words and figures “ 4.30 p.m. ” substituted therefor.

3. This order shall be deemed to operate and take effect as from the 30th day of May, 1921.
