

(6894.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT NURSERYMEN  
GARDENERS AND LANDSCAPE GARDENERS.—ORDER STRIKING  
OUT PARTY TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an application by John McLean, of Rotorua, Boardinghouse Proprietor, to be struck out of the list of parties to the Northern District Nurserymen Gardeners and Landscape Gardeners' award recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 1849.
