

(6896.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT (EXCEPT GISBORNE JUDICIAL DISTRICT) ELECTRICAL WORKERS.—ORDER ADDING PARTIES TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 12th day of October, 1920, known as the Northern Industrial District (except Gisborne Judicial District) Electrical Workers' award, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 1820.
