

(6946.) DUNEDIN (TWELVE-MILES RADIUS) HAIRDRESSERS'
ASSISTANTS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Dunedin (Twelve-miles Radius) Hairdressers' Assistants' award dated the 20th day of October, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 1924; and in the matter of an order amending the said award dated the 10th day of March, 1921, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxii, p. 307.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 7th day of July, 1921, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. The said order dated the 10th day of March, 1921, is hereby cancelled, and this order substituted therefor.

2. Clause 1 of the said award is hereby deleted, and the following provision is substituted therefor :—

“ Hours of Work.

“ 1. The hours of work shall be forty-eight per week, exclusive of meal-hours. The recognized hours of work in each establishment shall

be fixed by each employer according to the circumstances of his business, but the day's work shall end not later than 6 p.m. on three days of the week, and not later than 8 p.m. on one day of the week (except when a full holiday occurs in the same week), not later than 1 p.m. on the afternoon of the weekly half-holiday, and not later than 9 p.m. on one day of the week. On Christmas Eve 10 p.m., and on New Year's Eve and the night preceding Good Friday 9 p.m., shall be observed. During the six working-days preceding Christmas the hours of ceasing work shall be as follows: Three nights at 8 p.m., one night at 6 p.m. During the Winter and Summer Show weeks the hours for ceasing work shall be as follows: Three nights at 8 p.m., one night at 6 p.m., one night at 9 p.m."

3. Subclause (b) of clause 4 of the said award is hereby deleted, and the following provision is substituted therefor:—

"(b.) In addition to the above wage there shall be paid to such workers a bonus of 8s. per week unless and until the Court shall otherwise order."

4. This order shall operate and take effect as from the 25th day of July, 1921.
