

(6950.) DUNEDIN (NINETEEN-MILES RADIUS) LOCAL BODIES'  
LABOURERS.—ORDER ADDING PARTIES TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Dunedin (Nineteen-miles Radius) Local Bodies' Labourers' award dated the 20th day of October, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, folio 1959.

Wednesday, the 20th day of July, 1921.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 15th day of June, 1921, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the said union and such of the local bodies hereinafter named as appeared by their representative duly appointed, this Court doth order that the following be and they are hereby added as parties to the said award as from the date hereof:—

Oamaru Borough Council, Oamaru.

Oamaru Harbour Board, Oamaru.

Notwithstanding anything contained in clause 13 of the said award, the scope of the award shall be deemed to include, in respect of each of the parties above mentioned, the area covered by the operations respectively carried on by it.

Nothing in this award shall apply to the permanent workers employed by the Oamaru Harbour Board on the Harbourmaster's staff.
