## (6982.) DUNEDIN (FIFTEEN-MILES RADIUS) BUTCHERS.—EXEMPTION FROM CLOSING-HOURS.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; the Shops and Offices Amendment Act, 1920; and of an application by John Grainger, Butcher, of Fox Street, South Dunedin, for exemption from the operation of clause 14 of the Dunedin (fifteen-mile radius) Butchers' Award, recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxii, p. 432, as amended by order dated the 4th day of August, 1921.

Upon reading the application of the said John Grainger, filed herein on the 26th day of July, 1921, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the said John Grainger, and with the consent of all parties to the said award, this Court doth hereby exempt the said John Grainger from the operation of the closing-hour (clause numbered 14 of the said award) so long as the said John Grainger conducts his business under the conditions now existing and does not employ any labour. This exemption shall operate as from the 15th day of August, 1921, and shall continue until the Court shall otherwise order.
