

(7011.) WANGANUI AND RANGITIKEI DISTRICTS CARPENTERS
AND JOINERS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wanganui Carpenters and Joiners' award dated the 10th day of June, 1921, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxii, p. 967.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by section 92 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, this Court, being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say:—

1. By deleting subclauses (b), (c), and (d) of clause 3 of the said award, and substituting therefor the following provisions:—

“(b.) Workers engaged in the demolition of a building or any part thereof where dust is caused, or in repairs to or demolition of any building or fittings destroyed or damaged by fire which necessitate the handling of charred timber, shall be paid at the rate of time and a quarter while so engaged.

“(c.) Employers shall provide all benches, cramps, spanners, wire-cutters, and pinch-bars.”

2. This order shall be deemed to operate and take effect as from the 1st day of November, 1920.
