

(6485.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT (EXCEPT GISBORNE JUDICIAL DISTRICT) BAKERS' AND PASTRYCOOKS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918: and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District (except Gisborne Judicial District) Bakers and Pastrycooks' award dated the 14th day of October, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 1808.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 15th day of November, 1920, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Clause 2 of the said award is hereby amended by deleting the second paragraph of subclause (a) thereof, and substituting the following provisions therefor:—

“In addition to the minimum rates of wages prescribed in this subclause there shall be paid the following bonuses unless and until

the Court shall otherwise order: To all workers except bakers' labourers a bonus of 9s. per week, and to bakers' labourers a bonus of 3s. per week."

2. Clause 3 of the said award is hereby amended by adding the following subclause thereto:—

"(c.) In addition to the minimum rates of wages prescribed in this clause there shall be paid to each worker, unless and until the Court shall otherwise order, a bonus of 6d. per day of eight hours, or, in the case of a worker employed for less than eight hours, a bonus of $\frac{3}{4}$ d. per hour, with a minimum of 3d. in the latter case."

3. Clause 4 of the said award is hereby amended by adding the following subclause thereto:—

"(c.) In addition to the minimum rates of wages prescribed in this clause there shall be paid to each worker a bonus of 1s. per week unless and until the Court shall otherwise order."

4. Clause 12 of the said award is hereby amended by adding the following subclause thereto:—

"(k.) In addition to the minimum rates of wages prescribed in this clause there shall be paid to each apprentice a bonus of 1s. per week unless and until the Court shall otherwise order."

5. This order shall be deemed to operate and take effect as from the 1st day of November, 1920.
