(7031.) WANGANUI AND RANGITIKEI DISTRICTS CARPENTERS AND JOINERS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wanganui and Rangitikei Districts Carpenters and Joiners' award dated the 10th day of June, 1921, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxii, p. 967, and of an order amending the same dated the 23rd day of August, 1921.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by section 92 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, this Court, being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and at the request and by the consent of the parties to the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. The said order dated the 23rd day of August, 1921, is hereby cancelled.

2. Subclause (b) of clause 3 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following provision substituted therefor:—

“(b.) Any journeyman or apprentice working with pumice, charcoal, or silicate in connection with insulation work in any confined or unventilated space, or where the air is impregnated with the dust of any of these materials, or employed in freezing-chambers or cool storage where the temperature is 40 degrees or less, shall be paid time and a quarter while so employed, and shall be allowed ten minutes' spell after two hours have been worked continuously without any reduction of wages.”

3. This order shall operate and take effect as from the 1st day of November, 1920.
