

(6486.) FEDERATED COOKS AND STEWARDS AND NORTHERN STEAMSHIP COMPANY.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Federated Cooks and Stewards and Northern Steamship Company award dated the 18th day of October, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 1858.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 26th day of January, 1921, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Clause 2 of the said award is hereby amended by adding the following subclause:—

“(d.) In addition to the minimum rates of wages prescribed in this clause there shall be paid, unless and until the Court shall

otherwise order, the following bonuses: To all workers therein mentioned (except cadets) a bonus of 10s. per month, and to cadets a bonus of 3s. 6d. per month.”

2. This order shall be deemed to operate and take effect as from the 1st day of November, 1920.
