

(6487.) FEDERATED COOKS AND STEWARDS AND NORTHERN STEAMSHIP COMPANY.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Federated Cooks and Stewards and Northern Steamship Company award dated the 18th day of October, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 1858.

UPON reading the application of the Northern Steamship Company (Limited) filed herein on the 8th day of January, 1921, and after hearing the representatives of the parties and the witnesses called and examined and cross-examined by and on behalf of the said parties respectively, this Court doth order, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 92, subsection (1) (a), of the said Act, that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. The following words shall be added to subclause (a) of clause 6 of the said award:—

“The provisions of this clause as to the payment of one extra day’s sea-pay when a vessel leaves Auckland on a Sunday shall not apply to the steamers “Waimarie,” “Taniwha,” and “Kanieri” whilst engaged in their present trades, or to any vessels of the same character trading in substitution for the said vessels.”

2. This order shall be deemed to operate and take effect as from the date hereof.
