

(6503.) ROTORUA MAIL AND PASSENGER MOTOR AND COACH
DRIVERS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918; and in the matter of the Rotorua Mail and Passenger Motor and Coach Drivers' award dated the 28th day of October, 1919, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xx, p. 1197; and in the matter of an order amending the said award dated the 30th day of September, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 1668.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the said award filed herein on the 17th day of December, 1920, and upon hearing

the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, this Court, having regard to all the relevant considerations and being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, and by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Acts and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. The said order dated the 30th day of September, 1920, is hereby cancelled, and this order is substituted therefor.

2. The following subclause shall be added to clause 2 of the said award:—

“(d.) The minimum rates above prescribed shall be increased by a bonus of 13s. per week unless and until the Court shall otherwise order.”

3. Subclauses (a) and (c) of clause 3 of the said award shall be amended by increasing the rates for casual drivers by 3½d. per hour, and by increasing the rates for overtime, Sunday, and holiday work by 4d. per hour.

4. Clause 4 of the said award shall be amended by increasing the rate of overtime by 4d. per hour.

5. This order shall be deemed to operate and take effect as from the 1st day of November, 1920.
